Whether at home or at school, the children are putting such a lot into their studies

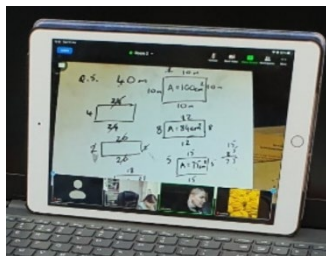

**THIS WEEK'S HANDBOOK UPDATES:** Rollout of Weekly Rapid / Lateral Flow Testing for KWP Staff- (w/c 18/01/21) a positive test result will require confirmatory PCR test and self-isolation until negative result is obtained. A positive test result of KWP staff is likely to affect the availability of KWP due to the small number of staff available. KW's should therefore have contingencies in place.

**Definition of Close Contact:** Spending 15 minutes within 2M of an infected person now includes 15 minutes accumulated over a period of 1 day.
